- The evaluation shall follow a **single stage procedure**.
- The evaluation criteria (including weights and thresholds) and sub-criteria, together with the eligibility, selection and award criteria, for the different funding schemes are set out in Annex 2 to the Guide for Applicants.
- **Consortium agreements:** participants in Collaborative Projects are required to conclude a consortium agreement; participants in Coordination and Support Actions are encouraged, but not required, to conclude a consortium agreement.
- **Forms of grant and maximum reimbursement rates:** the FP7 'Rules for Participation' propose three potential forms of grant for the Community financial contribution: reimbursement of eligible costs, flat rate financing including scale of unit costs, and lump sum financing.

In this work programme, for all funding schemes, the reimbursement of eligible costs (including the different options for flat rates on indirect costs as established in Article 32 of the Rules for Participation) will be the only form of grant used. Pursuant to Article 30 of the Rules for Participation, participants from International Cooperation Partner Countries may choose to opt for lump sum financing.

The upper limits foreseen in the Rules for Participation (Article 33) for the Community financial contribution are summarised in the following table:

- The **minimum number of participating legal entities** required, for all funding schemes, is set out in the Rules for Participation and outlined below:

Funding Scheme	Minimum conditions
Collaborative Project	At least 3 independent legal entities, each of which is established in a MS or AC, and no two of which are established in the same MS or AC
Coordination and Support Action (support type)	At least 1 independent legal entity
Research for the benefit of specific groups, such as SMEs	At least 3 independent legal entities, each of which is established in a MS or AC, and no two of which are established in the same MS or AC
