## **Resumen de la conferencia**

*Measurements of air and water temperatures show that Earth's climate is changing. Patterns of warming are widespread and stronger warming is observed in Arctic regions. Sea level is increasing worldwide, as shown by surface observations and by remote sensing instruments. Ice amounts on Greenland and Antarctica, as well as Arctic sea ice, are decreasing. Climate warming due to human-released greenhouse gases is very likely to be the main cause of the observed warming.*
